Ms. Mohsin, Mr. Schneider, Mr. Hauxhurst:

We kindly thank you for your August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020 response from Ms. Mohsin regarding our recent communication of presenting federal felony crimes to the Department of Justice and Federal Bureau of Investigation.

We respect your willingness to review the provided documentation and develop an initial conclusion, however we disagree with your decision to close the case. We appeal this decision and encourage you to reconsider.

We have two questions to ask:

- Mr. Schneider – have you reviewed all the provided information and stand by the decision made by Ms. Mohsin to officially close this case of undoubtable federal felony crimes being brought to your attention?
- Has this been brought to the attention of United States Attorney General William Barr?
  - It is our intention to bring this matter to Mr. Barr's attention

Mr. Schneider – In April, Mr. Barr tapped you to protect the constitutional rights and civil liberties of citizens. We stand with you to make sure that obligation is fulfilled.

We have faith in the Justice Department, we have faith in the supreme law of the land, we have faith that you will step up and do the right legal and lawful thing.

Undoubtably, with 18 USC 4 in mind, multiple federal felonies have been committed by, Michigan; Governor Gretchen Whitmer, AG Dana Nessel and Secretary of State Jocelyn Benson.

Should you stand by your initial conclusion will you please provide the reasoning or explanation as to why you believe these are not federal felonious crimes committed.

All that is done by the American Patriot Council will be conducted in a legal and lawful manor.
